5TH June 2025, World Environment Day

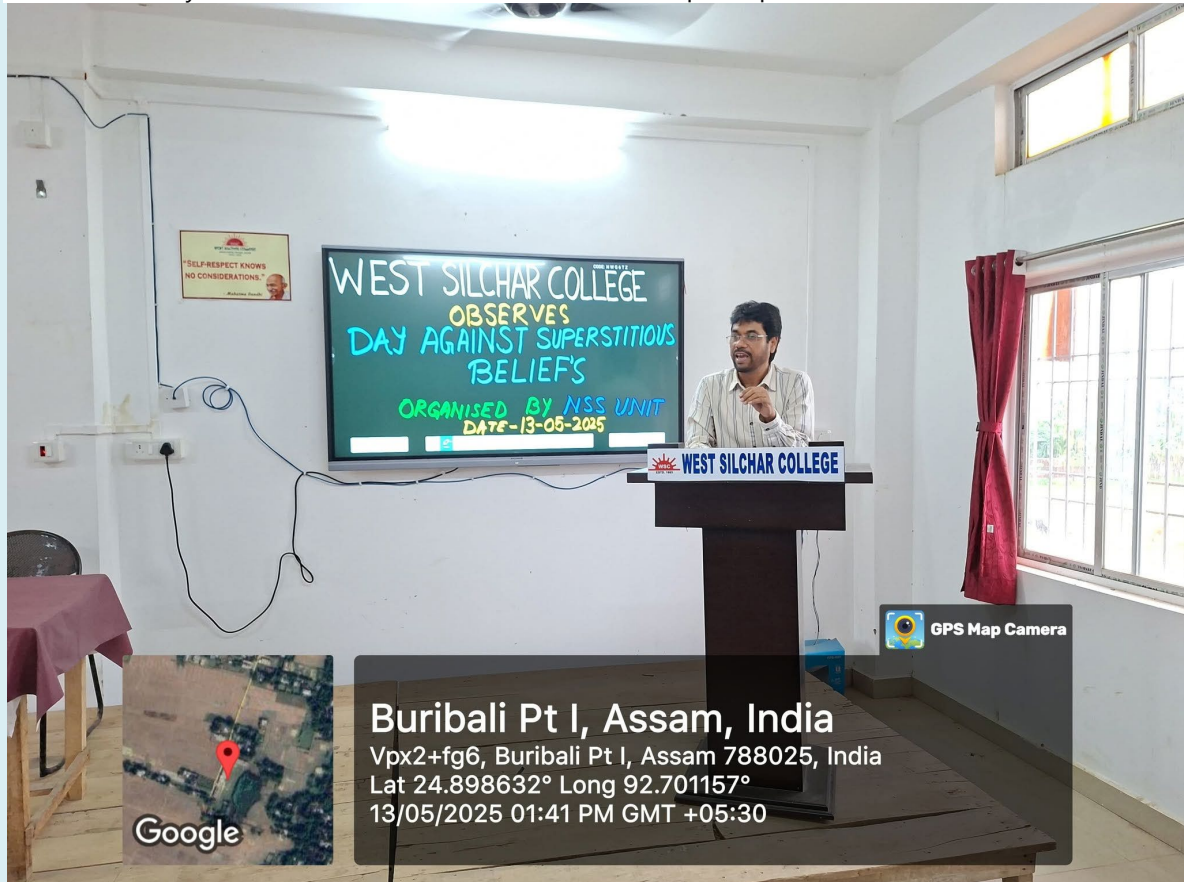

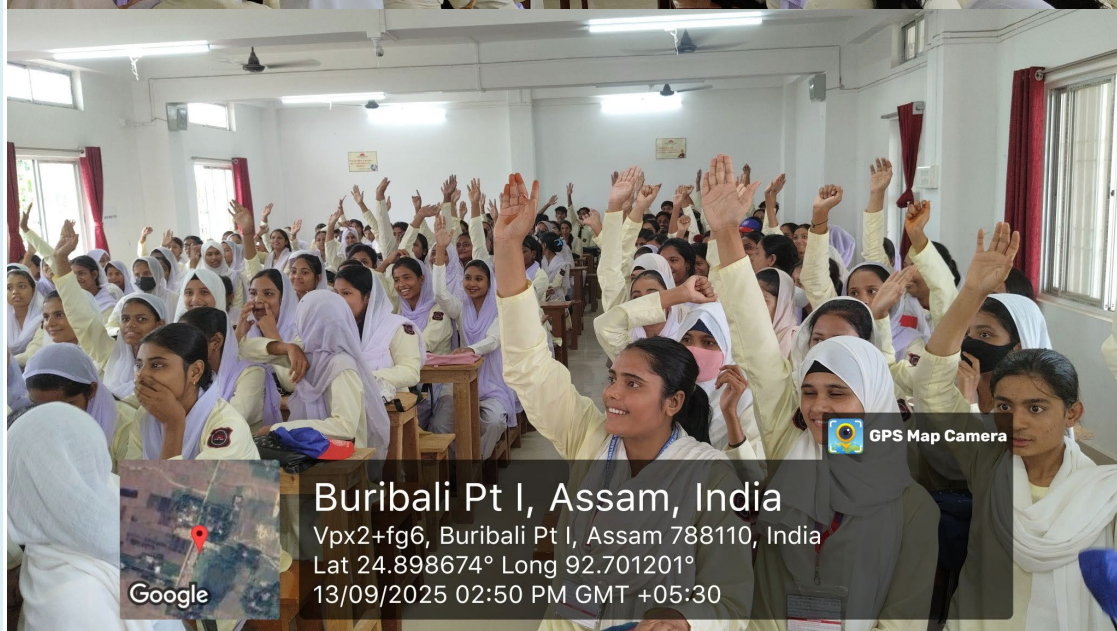
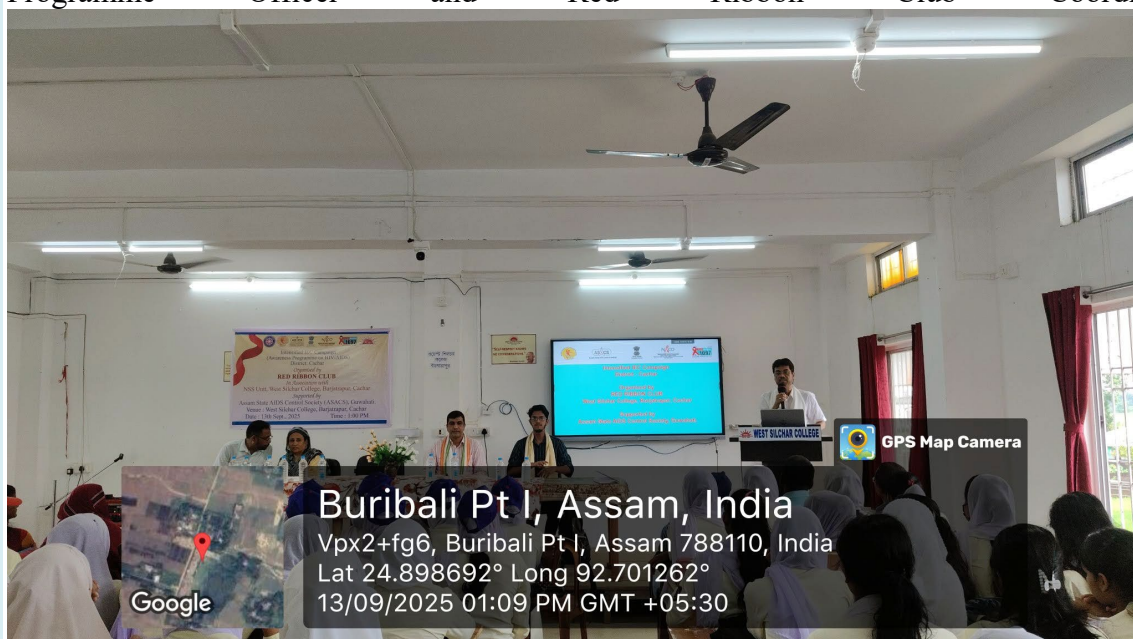
HIV/AIDS awareness camp 13 September 2025.

Dr. Sadeque Ahmed Laskar, NSS Program Officer, played crucial role in meticulously conducting the entire program.

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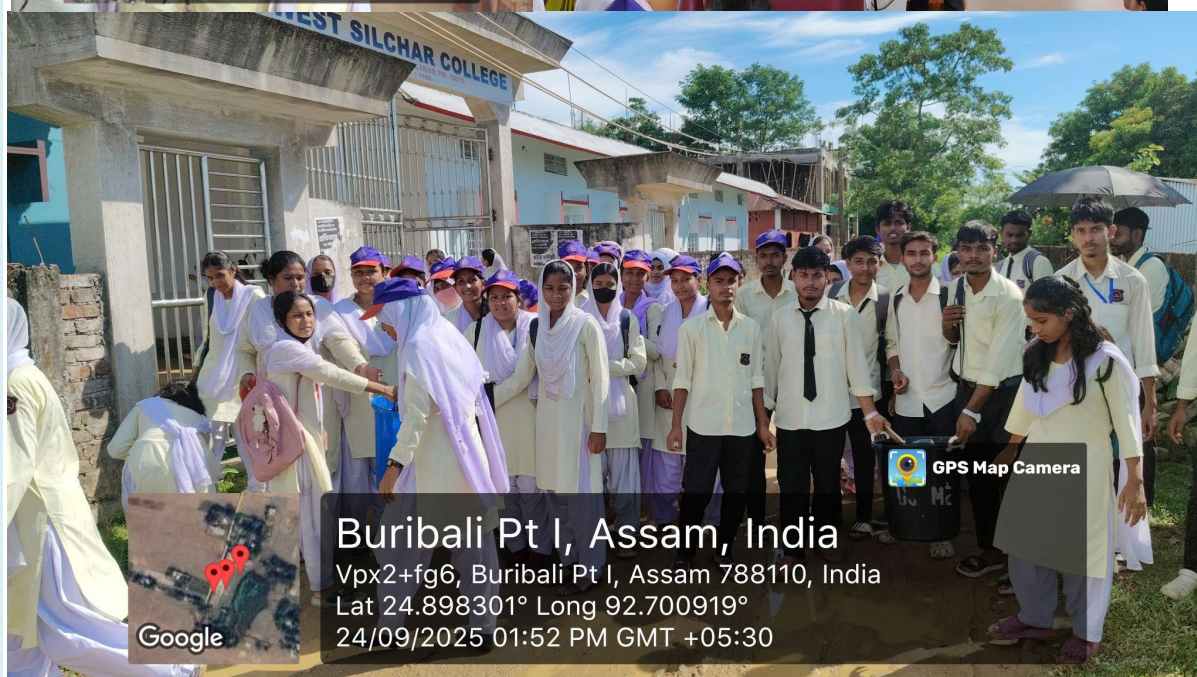
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17 November, 2025: NSS Achievement Alert! 🎉

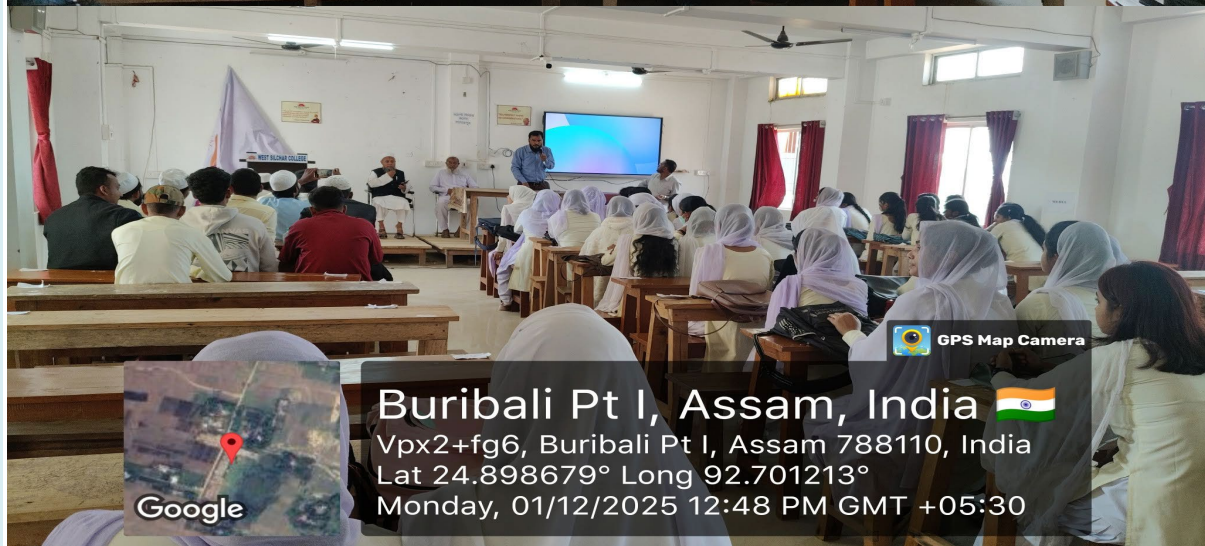
